- Start Boat Crews including timekeepers, flag signals and skippering
- Course Laying Boat Skippers and Crews
- Safety Boat Skippers and Crew
- Launching and Retrieving Sea Rescue Boats
- Support during major events (eg. State and National Championships)

Our volunteers range from those who volunteer regularly, to those who only volunteer once or twice a year. There is no minimum commitment required to volunteer. Any level of experience is welcomed!

Whilst some roles require certain qualifications, many of our roles only require a willingness to work as part of a team. The club can assist with helping you attain any certifications required to fulfill these roles.
